# **Student Guidelines for Financial Aid Degree Audit Requirements**

#### Do you receive Federal or State Financial Aid?

If you answered yes, there are some important changes coming your way beginning Fall 2022 that could affect your eligibility to receive federal/state financial aid. Review the guidelines below to ensure that you are adhering to the new requirements.

- **Register for at least 12 units of required coursework for full-time attendance**. Coursework that satisfies a requirement on your Degree Audit Report is considered a required course.
- Students taking an **ArtCenter Lite term** must enroll in **ONLY required courses** in order to receive their prorated financial aid award.
  - Be sure to review your Degree Audit Report after registering for classes to ensure that the course is located under a required area as shown below.

• **Coursework that does not meet a requirement on your Degree Audit Report will not be eligible for federal/state financial aid**. This includes all coursework that falls under the "Other Courses" area of your degree audit report as shown below.

- Students who have been approved to substitute a required course on their Degree Audit Report
  must submit the <u>Waive-Sub Form</u> to Enrollment Services preferably by Week 11 <u>before</u> the start of
  the term in which they plan to enroll in the course, in order to ensure they will receive their financial
  aid on time.
- Students should expect to have their aid prorated or removed if they are enrolled in less than 12 required units at the end of add/drop.

Following are some registration examples and a checklist to assist you.

## **Examples of Course Registration Regarding Federal/State Financial Aid**

## Student is:

<u>Registered for 16 units</u>, 12 count toward degree. Student will receive <u>all</u> federal student aid.
 <u>Registered for 16 units</u>, 0 count toward degree. Student will receive <u>no</u> federal student aid.
 <u>Registered for 12 units</u>, 9 count toward degree. Student aid will be prorated to 75%.
 <u>Registered for 9 units</u>, 6 count toward degree. Student aid will be prorated to 50%.

## Checklist

- $\sqrt{}$  Seek general advising early if you have questions about the registration process
- $\sqrt{}$  Seek major advising early if you have major-specific questions and/or requests for course substitutions
- $\sqrt{}$  Submit requests for course substitutions preferably by Week 11 before the start of the term
- $\sqrt{}$  Register!
  - Register in at least 12 units of required coursework to receive full-time federal/state financial aid disbursement
  - Students taking an ArtCenter Lite term must enroll in only required courses to receive prorated federal/state financial aid disbursement
- ✓ After registration, <u>review your Degree Audit Report (DAR)</u> to verify that at least 12 units are placed under a required area for full-time, or if taking a Lite term, all units are placed under a required area
  - Registered courses that fall under the "Other Courses" area of your DAR are not eligible for federal/state financial aid
