



Applications are now open for two study away scholarship opportunities with awards of up to \$5,000! Apply now for scholarships to study abroad in Summer or Fall 2016. **APPLICATION DEADLINES ARE MARCH 1 AND APRIL 1.** You do not have to be accepted to a study away program to apply, but you must be planning to go abroad in the Summer or Fall term. FREEMAN-ASIA SCHOLARSHIP

Freeman-ASIA is designed to support U.S.-based undergraduates with demonstrated financial need who are planning to study overseas in East or Southeast Asia. The program's goal is to increase the number of U.S. citizens and permanent residents with first-hand exposure to and understanding of Asia and its peoples and cultures. 400 scholarships are awarded annually.

Award Amounts: Up to \$5,000/term

Deadlines: March 1 for Summer programs; April 1 for Fall programs (e.g., Tama)

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident
2. Must be on financial aid (FAFSA)
3. Must be undergraduate pursuing first bachelor's degree
4. Must be studying abroad for at least 8 weeks (full term programs meet this requirement)
5. Must be studying abroad in Asia (**if you're thinking of applying to Tama in Fall 2016, this scholarship is for you!**)

GILMAN SCHOLARSHIP

The Gilman Scholarship Program aims to diversify the kinds of students who study and intern abroad and the countries and regions where they go by offering awards to U.S. undergraduates who might otherwise not participate due to financial constraints. Nearly 3,000 scholarships are awarded annually!

Award Amounts: Up to \$5,000/term

Deadlines: March 1 for Summer and Fall programs

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Must be receiving Pell Grant (high financial need)
2. Must be studying abroad for at least 4 weeks
3. Can study in any country except those listed on the U.S. State Department's Travel Warning List
