

Your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected by the Department of Education for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you reported on your 2020-2021 FAFSA. This process compares data from your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit them to the Financial Aid Office.
