# Lite Term Request

Lite Term Eligibility for Graduating Students:

- All graduating students are eligible to apply for a Lite Term in their final term.
- Student must have 11 credits or less of required remaining course requirements to be eligible.

# Leave of Absence (LOA) Request

If you have decided that you will take a Leave of Absence (LOA) for Spring 2024 instead of enrolling and completing your degree requirements, submit the LOA Form.

# **Incomplete Grade Policy**

- Graduating Students are ineligible to apply for Incomplete grade for any courses taken during their final term.
- Applying for incomplete grade will result in cancellation of your graduation application.

If you have an incomplete grade from a previous term, your grade change must be submitted prior to Week 14 of the term. Any incomplete grade in your records may delay the conferment of your degree.

# Distinction Eligibility for Masters Students

- Distinction for Masters Students:
  - Cumulative GPA of 3.97 or above, and
  - Portfolio review and/or recommendation from your department.

All eligible students will be contacted by email during Week 5.

# Distinction & Honors for Bachelors Students

- Distinction for Undergraduate Students:
  - Cumulative GPA of 3.80 or above, and
  - Portfolio review and/or recommendation from your department.

- -Honors for Undergraduate Students:
- Cumulative GPA between 3.50 and 3.79

# **Distinction & Honors Cont.**

## Commencement Program:

 Honors and Distinction will be indicated on the Commencement Program next to your name based on your current GPA. Current GPA appears on your Degree Progress/Degree Audit.


## Commencement Ceremony Walk:

 Honors and Distinction will be announced with your name during the Commencement Ceremony walk based on current GPA.

Students with a GPA on the border, may receive Distinction or Honors on their Diploma and Transcript after final grades are posted. However, for Commencement, the Honors and Distinction will be calculated based on current term GPA only.

# ArtCenter Honors & Graduate Fellows Term

- Selected by Provost Office
- No GPA Requirement
- All graduating students are eligible to apply
- Students who are awarded the program will be granted an additional term right after their graduating term to enroll at ArtCenter at no charge (with \$1,000 refundable deposit)




When you walk across the stage to receive your diploma a slide will appear on a screen above the stage with an image of your work.

Upload your image to the Grad Show website:

gradshow.artcenter.edu

When you create your Grad Show website profile you'll be able to upload your graduation image under the "Grad Show" tab.



The image should ideally represent your work. Grad students should upload an image representing their thesis.

PNG or jpeg images only. The site can't accept video files, gifs or PDFs.

Pixel dimensions: 1920 x 1080 px (horizontal)

We will add your name in the lower left corner. Here's an example:






# Be sure the image you upload doesn't have important information in the lower left corner!



If it does it will be difficult to read your name.

If you don't provide an image for graduation we will use a generic campus photo for your slide.

# Diplomas
